The University of San Diego will offer teachers one graduate unit for attending the Mariposa Storytelling Festival that is being held March 9-11.

The cost of the unit is: \$75

The instructors, Bob and Julie Gray, will be at the entrance to the festival for information and registration. Online registration will also be available. Transcripts will be sent to teachers, one-two weeks following the end of the festival.

Requirements: Attendance at the festival, followed by a short evaluation of the events, to include how oral presentations (such as folktales, poetry) can be applied to the classroom setting.
